The project aims at providing **technical support** to the Brussels regional employment agency, Actiris, to improve coordination between stakeholders active in the field of **labour market integration of newcomers** in the Brussels-Capital Region (BCR). Better coordination between stakeholders will ultimately lead to a better labour market participation rate among newcomers.

To that end, a **coordination platform** will be established that will remain an added value for the stakeholders in the long run. It is envisaged that the platform will consist of an in-person and digital component, consolidating a network of stakeholders while facilitating communication and exchange amongst them.

As this project is **needs-driven**, the IOM project team in coordination with Actiris will focus on establishing a **dialogue** with the relevant BCR stakeholders throughout the five phases as depicted below. Regular consultations with stakeholders will contribute to creating ownership and commitment, as well as to developing a coordination mechanism that is user-friendly, sustainable and tailored to their needs, wishes and expectations.
