



DIASPORA ENGAGEMENT TO SUPPORT TVET/HEALTH SECTOR IN RWANDA

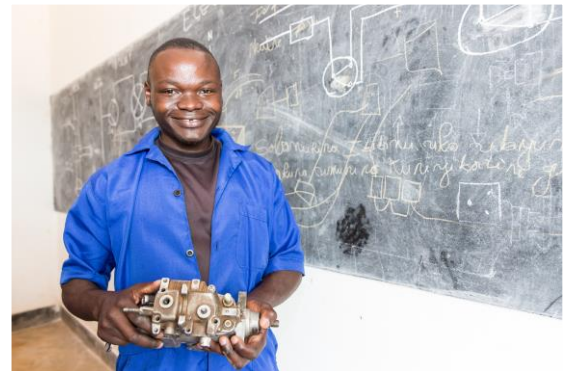
The International Organization for Migration (IOM) launches a new health and education project in Rwanda and is looking for interested Rwandans in Belgium

- **Conditions:** flight, transport, housing, daily allowance paid by IOM
