The organization “Maison Culturelle Belgo-Albanaise” established in Brussels on February 24, 2022, was created with the aim of becoming an important meeting point for the Albanian community in Belgium. After many years of privately advising, helping and serving as a contact point for a large number of Albanian migrants facing the everyday challenge of living in a foreign country, they decided to create a space for all those who seek help and support as well as for those who just want to connect with their community.

Through this project, Maison Culturelle Belgo-Albanaise aims to educate and support integration processes of Albanian migrants, offering practical knowledge and tools on how to access available services, especially to the most vulnerable people (women and young adults) facing everyday challenges in their migration story.

What we do?



Online and offline needs assessment to inform community-based activities



Developing an informative Digital Platform that will serve as a resource center for Albanian migrants



Host a radio broadcasting show at Radio Panik, dedicated to information on migrants rights and available support



Provide practical information sessions for asylum seekers in reception centers in Brussels and in Maison Culturelle



Distribution of informative leaflets to inform on rights and tools



Thematic priorities

- Informing migrants about basic rights
- Strengthening knowledge of available protection tools
