

OASIS WELKOM PROJECT



Ongoing project

Oasis Belgium was founded in 2007 with the aim of bringing hope, community and choice to those who are often marginalized and excluded from society. In Brussels the NGO focuses on supporting migrants who are victims of domestic abuse. Over the years the project has become increasingly known within the Thai community thanks to having 2 Thai speaking social workers on their team. In 2023 the team supported 160 beneficiaries of at least 16 different nationalities

Through this project, Oasis Belgium contributes to improving the ability of migrant women who are (at risk of being) a victim of domestic abuse and/or exploitation in Belgium to identify and access protection and integration services.

What we do?



Operating a help-line in French, English, Thai, Mandarin and Dutch



Individual assistance: accompaniment to lawyers, social services housing, children's services etc.



Workshops on self-esteem, writing a CV, rights in Belgium



Organising activity days such as visits infosession on rights, etc.



French classes to be able to better engage with needed services



Weekly drop-in group session as emotional support with a warm meal



Thematic priorities

- Psychosocial support to migrants
- Decreasing of vulnerabilities by strengthening the capacities of migrants
- Informing migrants about basic rights
- Engaging migrant communities through awareness-raising on available support in community-based activities
- Strengthening knowledge of available protection tools
