- Empower migrants and frontline services, by **raising awareness** on SGBV and migrants' rights.



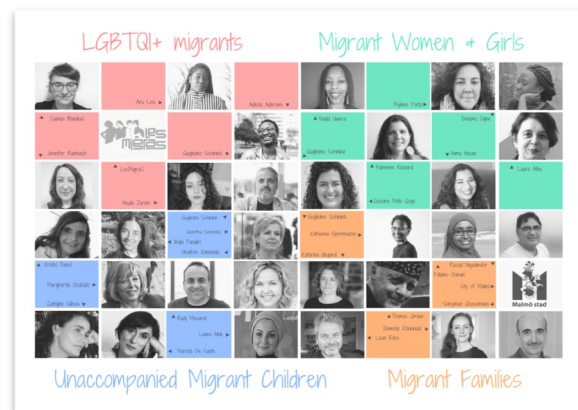
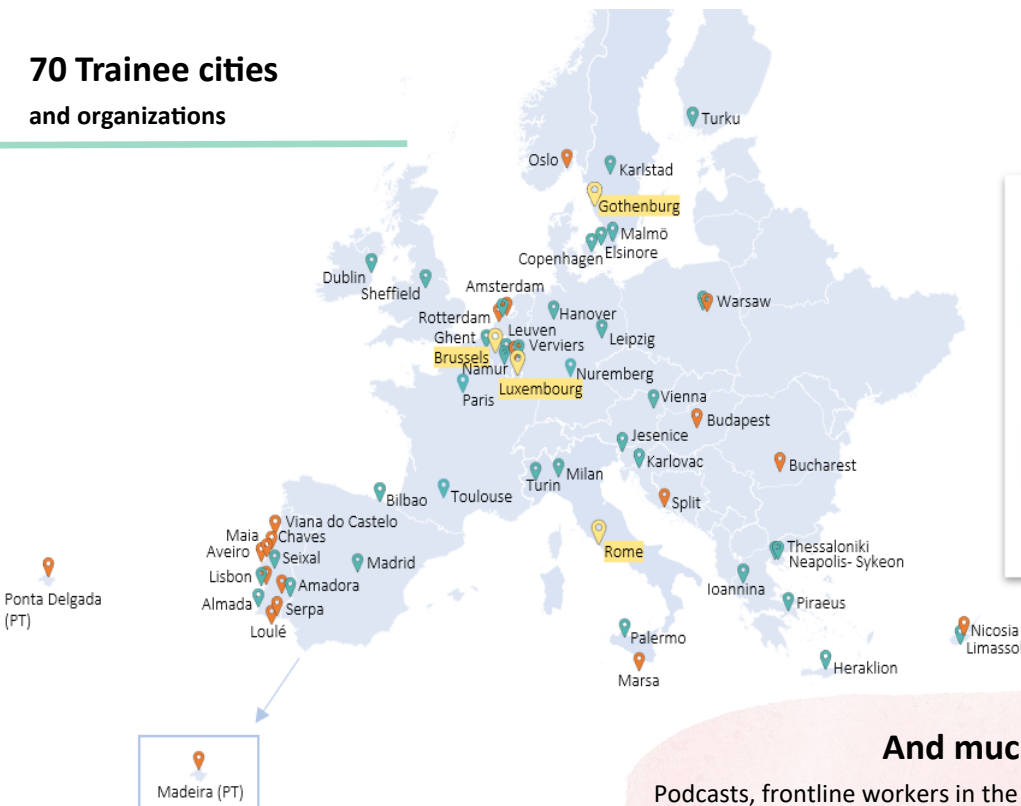
