Displaced Talent for Europe

The Displaced Talent for Europe (DT4E) project will enable **people in need of international protection in Jordan and Lebanon** to connect with employers and sustainably integrate into the **labour market in Belgium, Ireland, Portugal and the United Kingdom**. The project will set the foundations for displaced talent mobility schemes by testing **complementary migration pathways**, documenting best practices, identifying areas for policy reform and engaging the private sector as well as refugee-serving organizations.

Over a period of **three years**, the project is expected to:



Increase national support for displaced talent mobility, through strengthened partnerships and dialogue.



Engage employers in 4 European countries to address skills shortages through displaced talent mobility schemes.

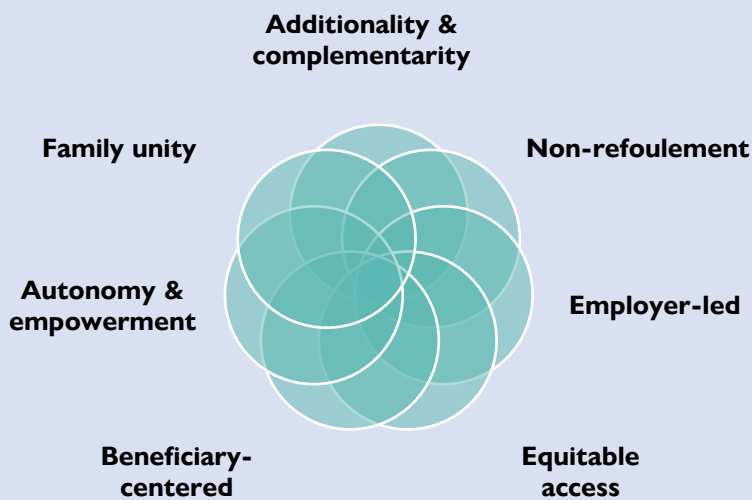


Support 250 displaced talents during job placement and integration, with pre-departure and post-arrival assistance.
